Vacation Bible School: Many Churches' Most Evangelistic Week All Year

- Ensure volunteers are properly screened and backgrounded for the protection of children, church, and ministry.
- 2. Ensure volunteers are properly trained on the material, church's policies regarding children, and are not unprepared for teaching.
- 3. Develop a safety plan and brief teachers/volunteers on enacting it.
- 4. Publicize!!! Invite!!! Incentivize if necessary!
- 5. Pray. Pray constantly. Ask others to pray. Develop a prayer ministry that is ongoing during VBS; enlist those who can no longer serve AT church.
- Develop a follow-up plan NOW. Small gift bags, with a follow-up visit on Sunday after VBS, and a mailed postcard inviting the children to regular church activities can go a long way in follow-up.
- 7. Plan a night of celebration & Baptism NOW, trusting the Lord to fulfill His promises!
