As we prepare the June newsletter, it's been

the Associational Missionary. In that year, I have learned a lot, made many visits, and begun the process of encouraging us all toward "Better." In the last 11 months I personally visited 31

of the Association's 44 churches—roughly 70%—at least once. I have made contact

through other means with an additional 10% of the churches.

The Association supported its first mission trip to Whitley City, Kentucky, to deliver backpacks and the Gospel message to families there, and helped connect the ladies ministry of one of our Associational churches with opportunities to serve in Kentucky. Our Disaster Relief unit, one of my early goals, is off the ground—with the Lord providing trailers, money for equipment, and a \$10,000 grant toward a shower trailer. We will soon be ready to respond when disaster strikes! In fact, members of the WBA who are Disaster-Relief-certified already responded to the January tornado in Sandersville and the March tornado in Milledgeville. The WBA has grown by three church bodies and has another under Watch-care currently! We hosted our first Missions Fair in several years and I have taken exploratory trips to Michigan and Nicaragua to look for ways to serve people there and partner with pastors in those areas!
