## Camp Rules for campers and parents

1. Age requirement: Camp is for those who have completed 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades.
2. Please complete the camp application completely and return directly to WBA with the \$50.00 deposit or the total amount of \$150 (if registering by 4/30) or \$175 (if registering 5/1 or after). Registration is NOT complete without final payment, which must be received no later than Friday, June 14th.
3. Sign-in will begin at 1:30 p.m. on Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup>. No one will be checked in before 1:30pm.
4. Camp ends after clearance by the Camp Director on Saturday, July 13<sup>th</sup>. Final dismissal should be no later than 11 AM—please plan accordingly. Do not leave the campground without dismissal from security. Campers will be released by security to those authorized to pick them up, or they will leave with the groups with which they came.
5. Cancellation Policy: Any refund request must be in writing. A refund request made at least 7 days before camp begins will receive a full refund. A cancellation or refund request made after July 1, 2024 will not receive a refund. No-shows will also not be issued a refund.
6. Transportation to and from camp is the responsibility of each church group. Please coordinate with the church listed on your application.
7. Items TO bring:
  - Sheets for twin bed or sleeping bags, pillow & pillowcase, light blanket
  - Bath Towel, Beach Towel, washcloths, shower shoes
  - Personal hygiene items: soap, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush, comb, brush
  - Casual dress: comfortable shoes, socks, blue jeans, shorts (not short-shorts), shirts (no halter tops), underwear. We recommend 2 sets per day.
  - ***Modest swim suits (both boys & girls dark t-shirts/shorts)***
  - Bible, pen, notebook; backpack for carrying these items.
  - Flashlight
  - Insect repellent, sunscreen, aloe
  - Hat or cap
  - Floor fan
  - Medication
  - Refillable water bottle; hydration gear
  - Quarters & \$1 bills for the camp store, which will be open once daily
8. Items NOT to bring
  - No cell phones preferred – we are NOT responsible for lost or stolen items, students will be encouraged to put them away, and there's not good reception anyway.
  - Tobacco or alcohol products (including vapes, e-cigarettes, etc.)
  - Knives, guns, or any other weapons
  - Water guns or balloons
  - T-shirts with non-Christian advertisement
  - Immodest swimwear for males or females
  - Bandanas
  - Food, drinks or coolers
  - Pornography in any form

# NEW THIS YEAR

We are at a BRAND NEW Campground this year. With a new place, we have new opportunities!

There is a Disc Golf Course, a pool, indoor basketball and outdoor volleyball. These will all come into play for our REC experience.

## REC

Our REC will have both competitive and non-competitive options. If you want to go competitive, we will have teams of 5 participating in either 3-on-3 basketball and/or 5-on-5 volleyball. Here's the kicker, you can set your teams BEFORE camp! Each team must have at least 2 girls. In the 3-on-3 basketball tourney, a girl must be on the court at all times. ## Journeyman Class

In many trades, like blacksmithing, before you could be a blacksmith you had to learn the trade through a journeyman process. This class will be with the camp pastor, and will dive deeper into the material as well as offer some opportunities for leadership.
