There is already a LOT of excitement around our December 8-11 Mission Trip to Kentucky. As of the day I am writing this, we already have 14 who have expressed interest! I have had several questions about the trip, so I wanted to take this opportunity to answer a few of those questions and give the details as we have them. We will have an informational meeting about the Mission Trip on October 11, immediately following our Annual Meeting. This will be a brief meeting to set a time and place for a more in depth meeting.

Here is the basic schedule:

- Thursday, December 8th—Travel day—How we travel will be based on the number of people. If you should choose to travel on your own, we will coordinate arrival and hotel check-in.
- Friday, December 9th—Set-up and prep for distribution
- Saturday, December 10th—Distribution of backpacks—I hope to have more details about the how and where when we meet in October.
- Sunday, December 11th—Travel Day—There will be an option to worship with Crossroads Community Baptist Church or just make our way back that morning. We can discuss this at the meeting.

Questions I've been asked:

1. Where will we stay? There are basically two options: A local hotel or a local Missions and Ministry center. The hotel is not fancy but it is safe and has all the things you'd expect. The Mission center is more bare bones and has bunkbeds and community bathrooms.
2. How much will it cost? My goal is to keep the upfront cost down. Until we know where we are staying I cannot be certain, but the plan is to keep the cost under \$150/person.
3. Who can go? Anyone that is willing to serve. I have had 5 year olds and 80 year olds. Just be willing to serve and I can put you to work.

My prayer is that this will become a long-term partnership with Grant and Gina Hasty and their work in Kentucky. Pastors, I would love for you to join me and come see all the possibilities for future ministry there, including the Lord's Cafe and The Light Community. I know this will be a great trip for all who can attend. Come be a part of our first trip together! Lord willing, it will be the first of many that the WBA does in our quest to be #OnMissionTogether.
